the United States Department of the Interior National Park Service*



WHEREAS, the statutory aid granted by congress has positioned the City of Selma to move forward in this endeavor , the City would like to solicit proposals for professional services necessary to continue progress on the Selma Voting Rights and Interpretive Center project; *and*

Circular A-102 Attachment O and the Common Rule as adopted by the State of Alabama, and therefore desires to properly advertise its requests for proposals for Program Administration and Engineering Services as set forth therein.




