**WHEREAS**, the City did advertise for Request for Proposals for administrative services in The Selma Times-Journal and in the Montgomery Advertiser on August 20, 2009 and August 27, 2009; and has determined that the Proposal for Administrative Services submitted by Galbraith and Associates is the most acceptable; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the City has complied fully with the procurement requirements as set forth in O.M.B. Circular A-102 Attachment O, and the Common Rule as adopted by the State of Alabama.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council that George Evans in his capacity as Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Galbraith and Associates in the amount of \$32,000.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama that:


