Authorization to enter into agreement with

McKEE & ASSOCIATES ARCHITECTURE AND INTERIOR DESIGN

*Architectural Services as it relates to the
Public Buildings Renovation Bond Projects*

WHEREAS, the CITY OF SELMA has passed a bond referendum to fund major projects including renovations to various public buildings to include the Police Department Buildings, Fire Stations #2, 3, 4 and 5, the Animal Shelter, City Hall , the Convention Center, the Performing Arts Center, the Red School House/Red Cross Building, Vaughn-Smitherman Museum, White Force Cottage, and Public Library ; *and*

WHEREAS, the City Requested Proposals for architectural services and received responses from six firms and the City has determined that the proposal submitted by McKee and Associates Architecture and Interior Design is the most acceptable; *and*

WHEREAS, George P. Evans in his capacity as Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a contract with McKee and Associates to be compensated at 7.1% of construction cost.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama that:

George Patrick Evans, in his capacity as Mayor, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with McKee and Associates Architecture and Interior Design to perform architectural services for the **City of Selma Public Buildings Renovation Bond Projects** as set forth in its proposal.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the incurred expenses of the agreement are obligated in the 2009 Bond Referendum.




